

Medical Volunteer Appreciation Policy

Medical volunteers are critical to the success of Element 11. Medical volunteers' efforts require specialized training and certifications and volunteering is sometimes difficult and stressful. These efforts are deeply appreciated by the Element 11 Board of Directors (BOD) and the larger Utah community. To recognize and show appreciation for these efforts and to hopefully encourage Medical volunteers to continue to assist at the event and with the community, the following Volunteer Appreciation Policy has been established for the E11 Medical Department:

Credit Hours

- 1 hour worked during Element 11 between 9am and 12am (midnight) = 1.5 volunteer credit hours.
- 1 hour worked during Element 11 Graveyard Shifts (12 midnight-9am), during a burn, or any Sunday shift = 2 volunteer credit hours.
- Any unscheduled "response time" (such as a medical emergency) worked during the event will also be credited 1:1. Please communicate the extra hours spent to the Event Medical Lead.
- Element 11 Medical Team Leads (requires medical license or certification, such as MD, RN, EMT, etc) and Out-of-State medical volunteers - a gift ticket may be granted in advance of the event with a commitment to work 3 Medical Team Lead shifts (Team Lead Shifts are 8 hours) or more. The gift ticket will be approved and coordinated through the Medical Director. Team Leads that are gifted an event ticket will not accrue medical credit hours (but may accrue hours in other departments). Failure to complete all 3 committed shifts may result in event eviction or other punitive actions at the discretion of the Medical Director. Please contact the Medical Director for additional details.
- Credit also be given (1:1) for Ranger Training (ROM).
- New FirstAid/CPR certification training will be given a 1-hour credit.
- Online FEMA NIMS IS-700.A, ISC IS-100.B, ISC IS-200.B training will be credited 3 hours, once every three years. A copy of the completion certificate(s) must be provided to the Medical Director and EOC Department for credit.
- Other special projects or activities that directly benefit Element 11 may also be approved for credit hours. Please discuss, in advance, with the Medical Director.
