



UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE REGISTRATION POLICY & PROCESS

All participants under the age of 18 years old entering the Element 11 event, will be required to be registered to help identify children who are lost, stray, or have other needs. See the accompanying "YoungBurnerForm".

The form must be completed upon arrival at the event. Should the camping location be unknown upon arrival, that section may be left blank until camp is made & the parent/guardian returns to the gate with the information. **The gate should retain the parent/guardian's driver's license until they return with their camp information.**

Completed forms should be sent to Ranger HQ at the end of each gate shift for filing by wristband number. Completed forms will only be available to the Ranger Lead, Medical Lead, Khaki, or other Incident Commander, as necessart.

Underage participants will be issued a numeric wristband with the number being captured on the Young Burner Form.

Should a Ranger encounter a found child, stray child, or child with other needs, the Ranger should obtain the child's wristband number, radio Khaki, and receive all pertinent information regarding the child (Camp location, parent/guardian, child's name, etc.).
