

Electric Bike Policy

Electric bikes are welcome at the Element 11 event, but must adhere to this set of guidelines at all times.

Electric Bike Classification

We adhere to Burning Man's definition of an electric bike. E-bikes must:

1. Be generally recognized as a bicycle
2. Have 2-3 wheels
3. Have working pedals
4. Have an electric motor, up to 750 watts
5. Have a top rated speed of no more than 20 mph with 170 lb. operator
6. Not be a moped

Speed limit

The speed limit in the city is 5 miles per hour for all vehicles and powered bikes.

Parking

Electric bikes may not be parked on the road at any time.

Night riding

A headlight and tail light are required for night riding.

Disciplinary Action

Riders must adhere to these, and all other Element 11 policies at all times. Riders must follow directions given by rangers, board members, security, and law enforcement immediately and without argument. Failure to do so may result in warnings (first offense), temporary revocation of driving privileges for the day (second offense), confiscation of E-bike for the duration of the event (third offense), and ejection from the event with a ban from future events. Any of these steps can be taken at any time at the discretion of the authorities mentioned above, up to and including ejection should the offense be deemed serious enough to warrant.
